



Olivier Latry Organ Concert and Conferences at the University of Kansas: November 8, 9, & 10

The University of Kansas, School of Music, Division of Organ and Church Music is delighted to announce the first in a series of conferences on French organ music. Our initial conference in this series is entitled:

Le Grand Siecle:

Organ Music and Culture in 17th and 18th Century France

These conferences will be centered around the teaching of Olivier Latry, the *new* William T. Kemper Artist-in-Residence at the University of Kansas, in conjunction with lectures and performances by resident and guest conference faculty. This conference will occur on November 8th and 9th 2019. Olivier Latry will present a lecture on the French Classic organ as well as master classes covering all of the major genres and composers of French classic organ music. ST. LOUIS SCOTTISH RITE CATHEDRAL KIMBALL ORGAN FUND:

The Scottish Rite Cathedral is establishing a special fund for the benefit of its historic Kimball organ through donations so that, as the fund grows over time, only the interest generated by the fund might be used for the organ's maintenance and estimate preservation.

To help in this effort, a special CD is being offered in exchange for supporting it, and a gift-for-a-gift. (Suggested donation being \$20/each). This CD contains pdf files of the scores for 32 brand new pieces for organ written with the sound of this instrument in mind, along with computer generated mp3 audio clips for these same pieces and doc files having suggestions for performance of each piece.


